Subject: Special Data Call
New Hampshire Losses from Tropical Storm Irene

It looks like Tropical Storm Irene has resulted in significant damage and flooding along the east coast, and NH has come in for its share. The storm and its aftermath will have impacts on many property owners and business operations throughout the state. As an insurer writing business in New Hampshire, the Department understands that you have been receiving calls, inquiries and claim reports from your insureds as a result of the storm.

In order for the Department to fully understand and quantify the magnitude of insured losses and to help evaluate any uninsured losses resulting from Tropical Storm Irene and the effect on New Hampshire citizens and communities, I am directing all insurers licensed by New Hampshire and who write property and casualty insurance, to respond to a special data call. The data call consists of a series of reports, due monthly over the next four months. The Department is requesting that the claims be grouped by type of insurance, location of the property and size of the loss.
