NH Insurance Department SUD Market Conduct Exam Update - December 5, 2016

<u>Procedural status</u> (see reverse side for more detail on the statutory process):

- Three exams are underway, still at confidential stage
- Verified written reports issued for all; Examined companies' responses due December 5
- Next steps:
 - o Commissioner has 30 days to review reports and companies' responses
 - o Then: issue order to company OR direct reopening of exam OR investigatory hearing
 - Company has 20 days from order to request closed meeting
 - Then: Final order, filing of report
 - After filing, Commissioner may open report for **public inspection**
- Likely timing for making exam results public: Late December/early January
