

The session will begin at 9 a.m. (coffee and light refreshments will be available beginning at 8:30 a.m.) at the University of New Hampshire School of Law, just outside downtown Concord. The school is located at the intersection of Washington and White Streets, and the event will be held in Room 282 in the law school's easternmost section, the Franklin Pierce Center for Intellectual Property.

(For mapping purposes, the school's address is 2 White Street, and you may find the most parking off White Street, and in the White Park parking lot.)

Once you arrive at the law school, you'll be able to find on-street parking (without fear of a ticket) along Washington and White streets. **Please enter the school via the easternmost entrance, the Franklin Pierce Center for Intellectual Property (at the intersection of Washington and Rumford streets).** Once you've entered the building, you'll see a winding staircase to an upstairs balcony (an elevator also is available, just a few feet inside the lobby you'll enter). We'll be hosting the event in Room 282, just upstairs. Please come and say hello at the registration table beforehand, and we'll make sure we've checked you off our list, given you a copy of the agenda, and allowed you the opportunity to sign up to make a public comment.
