NHID'S ASSENTED TO MOTION TO DELAY SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED DECISION

NOW COMES the New Hampshire Insurance Department ("NHID") by and through its counsel, and hereby requests that the Hearing Officer delay the submission of a proposed decision in this matter until 35 days following the hearing, and in support thereof, states as follows:

- 1. An adjudicatory hearing was held on this matter on March 5, 2024.
- 2. Though he had not communicated with the NHID beforehand, Respondent appeared at the hearing and testified about his conduct and the conduct of others. Significantly, Respondent took responsibility for his actions and apologized for failing to respond to the NHID's earlier requests.
- 3. Following the conclusion of the adjudicatory hearing, Respondent met with counsel for the NHID for some time to discuss in greater detail his actions and prior workplace.
- 4. Pursuant to Ins 207.04(a)(1), the hearing officer in this matter must submit a proposed decision within 35 days of the conclusion of the hearing.
- 5. The NHID and Respondent are in discussions to resolve this matter via a consent order; pursuant to Ins 207.01(a) the NHID now requests that the hearing officer delay the submission of the proposed decision until 35 days after the hearing, to allow the parties time to discuss resolution through a consent order in the next few weeks.
- 6. Respondent has assented to this request.
 - WHEREFORE, the NHID respectfully requests that the Hearing Officer:
- A. Delay the submission of a proposed decision until 35 days following the conclusion of the hearing; and

B. For other relief as is just and proper.
