FACTS

A. On March 18, 2009, Hewitt Associates, LLC ("Hewitt") filed an application for a non-resident insurance producer license ("Application") through the National Insurance Producer Registry. Under Background Questions, Hewitt answered "No" to question 2, indicating that it had not been involved in any administrative proceeding regarding the company's professional or occupational license. In the Attestation Statement, Hewitt certified that the information submitted on the Application was true and complete.

B. Through the routine licensing investigation, the following information was found on the NAIC I-Site:

1. On May 30, 2006, the Wisconsin Office of Commission of Insurance fined Hewitt Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for failure to reply to an inquiry from the Commissioner.

2. On December 20, 2007, the Indiana Department of Insurance suspended Hewitt's license for failure to respond and provide a list of company appointments.

C. The facts contained in paragraphs A and B above constitutes a violation of RSA 402-J:12 I, (a):

"I. The commissioner may place on probation, suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license, or may levy a penalty in accordance with RSA 400-A:15, III or any combination of actions for any one or more of the following causes:

(a) Providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in the license application.

AGREEMENT AND ORDER

To resolve this matter, Hewitt consents and agrees to the following Order of the Commissioner:

1. Hewitt knowingly waives the statutory right to notice and hearing on this matter.
2. Hewitt shall pay an administrative penalty in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250) to the New Hampshire Insurance Department. The administrative penalty shall be made payable to the Treasurer, State of New Hampshire. The administrative

penalty shall be payable upon Respondent's execution of this Consent Order and Agreement ("Consent Order").

3. Upon receipt of the signed Consent Order and penalty payment, the Department shall issue the insurance producer license to Hewitt.

4. The Department and Hewitt agree that all insurance regulatory issues relating to the aforementioned violation are fully resolved. However, nothing herein shall prohibit the use of this Consent Order in any future enforcement actions brought by the Department based upon subsequent matters relative to Respondent's compliance with applicable insurance law and/or regulation.

5. This Consent Order shall be fully enforceable in any Superior Court in the State of New Hampshire.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
