**In Re: James Page Insurance Agency Inc.**

**Consent Order and Settlement Agreement**

**Docket No.: 12-026-EP**

This Consent Order and Agreement ("Order") is made between the New Hampshire Insurance Department ("Department") and the James Page Insurance Agency Inc. ("Respondent"), the terms of which are as follows:

1. The Respondent's nonresident insurance producer's license was due to renew on or before May 31, 2012. The license was not renewed and lapsed on June 1, 2012. Company appointments for the Agency were all terminated effective June 1, 2012. Respondent applied for licensure reinstatement through NIPR on July 2, 2012 and the license was effective on July 2, 2012. Company appointments were not reinstated as of July 31, 2012.
2. While conducting a review the series of events described immediately above the Department determined that Respondent had violated several sections of RSA 402-J. These are as follows:
  - a. Respondent was not licensed and not appointed with any insurance company for the period June 1, 2012 through July 1, 2012. During this time the Respondent, as producer of record, wrote two (2) new business insurance policies. This is two (2) violations of RSA 402-J:3 License Required.
  - b. Respondent was licensed but not appointed with any insurance company for the period July 2, 2012 through July 31, 2012. During this time the Respondent, as producer of record, wrote one (1) new business insurance policy. This is one (1) violation of RSA 402-J:14 Appointments and Authority.

WHEREFORE, for the purpose of settling the above referenced matters and in lieu of an administrative proceeding, the Department and the Respondent reached an agreement whereby Respondent consents to the following terms of this Order:

- A. The Respondent agrees that the statutory violations cited above are true and accurate.
- B. The Respondent waives the statutory right to an adjudicatory hearing on this matter.
- C. The Respondent agrees to pay an administrative penalty in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) made payable to "Treasurer, State of New Hampshire" and mailed to the New Hampshire Insurance Department, 21 South Fruit Street, Suite 14, Concord, New Hampshire 03301, to the attention of Ms. Carolyn Petersen.


D. Unless the signed Consent Order and Agreement and check are returned to the Department within 30 days from the date of mailing the Consent Order and Agreement to Respondent, then the Department has the right to commence administrative action against the Respondent as deemed appropriate.

E. This Consent Order shall be fully enforceable in any Superior Court in the State of New Hampshire.


