CONSENT ORDER AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Consent Order and Settlement Agreement (“Agreement”) is made this 18th day of January 2013 between the New Hampshire Insurance Department (“NHID”) and Pamela F. Burrow, formerly Pamela F. Blowen, (“Ms. Burrow”), a New Hampshire resident insurance producer, National Producer # 8564019.

WHEREAS, Ms. Burrow was the registered agent, principal and Designated Responsible Licensed Producer for Lunar Title LLC. On or about April 20, 2011, Old Republic National Title Insurance Company (“ORNTIC”) conducted a recertification audit of Lunar Title LLC.

WHEREAS, as a result of the recertification audit, ORNTIC suspended its agency contract with Lunar Title LLC for late recordings, effective April 25, 2011, and on July 18, 2011, ORNTIC cancelled its agency contract with Lunar Title LLC.

WHEREAS, ORNTIC conducted two exit audits of Lunar Title LLC’s books and records and determined the escrow account was deficient by \$23,644.67.

WHEREAS, Ms. Burrow admits that the escrow account was deficient by \$23,644.67 and that these monies were the property of and due ORNTIC.

WHEREAS, Ms. Burrow has repaid \$10,000 to ORNTIC, and executed a Promissory Note in favor of ORNTIC for the remaining balance of \$13,644.67.

WHEREAS, the NHID has never received any consumer complaints regarding Ms. Burrows and is unaware of any harm to consumers as a result of Ms. Burrows' misconduct.

WHEREAS, Ms. Burrow admits that the facts recited above are true and accurate, and constitute a violation of RSA 402-J:12, I (h).

WHEREFORE, for the purpose of resolving the above-referenced matter and in lieu of further administrative proceedings, the NHID and Ms. Burrow have reached an agreement as follows:

- A. The foregoing recitals are hereby adopted, incorporated and made a part of this Consent Order and Settlement Agreement.
- B. Ms. Burrow admits to violating RSA 402-J:12, I (h).
- C. Ms. Burrow's New Hampshire producer license shall be revoked, effective immediately upon the NHID's and Ms. Burrow's execution of this Consent Order and Settlement Agreement.
- D. Ms. Burrow waives her right to an adjudicatory hearing on the facts and allegation recited above.
- E. By entering into this Consent Order and Settlement Agreement, the NHID and Ms. Burrow intend to resolve all issues relating to the matters recited above, and this Consent Order and Settlement Agreement shall be deemed a full and final resolution of the allegations recited above.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
