NOTICE OF HEARING

STATEMENT OF ISSUES

1. On January 18, 2014, Douglas A. Bevins ("Petitioner") submitted an application to State of New Hampshire Insurance Department ("Department") for a resident New Hampshire insurance producer's license.
2. By correspondence dated February 19, 2014, that application was denied.
3. On April 18, 2014, Petitioner submitted a second application for a resident New Hampshire producer's license.
4. By correspondence dated June 17, 2014, that application was also denied. The basis for the denial as set forth in the June 17 letter is the revocation of the Petitioner's non-resident insurance producer's license in the state of Maine, pursuant to a Consent Agreement dated November 20, 2012. Pursuant to the provisions of RSA 402-J:12,I(i) a New Hampshire insurance producer license can be denied if the applicant's license has been denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state.
5. On June 23, 2014, Petitioner sent a letter to Commissioner Roger A. Sevigny, New Hampshire Insurance Department, to appeal the June 17 denial, and request a hearing, pursuant to RSA 400-A:17.

NOTICE OF HEARING

6. Pursuant to New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated RSA 400-A:17, an adjudicative hearing shall commence on **Tuesday, July 22, 2014, at 9:30 a.m.** at the offices of the New Hampshire Insurance Department, 21 South Fruit Street, Suite 14 in Concord, New Hampshire. All parties shall have the opportunity to respond and present evidence and argument on all issues involved.
7. The hearing shall be conducted pursuant to the practices and procedures set forth in RSA 541-A; RSA 400-A; and New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Ins 200, Practices and Procedures.

8. Russell F. Hilliard, Esquire shall act as the Insurance Commissioner's representative and preside at the hearing as Hearing Officer.
9. Sarah Prescott shall serve as clerk to the Hearing Officer. The parties should direct all communications to Ms. Prescott, whose contact information is:

10. Richard P. McCaffrey, the NHID's Compliance and Enforcement Counsel, shall appear as staff advocate, representing the interests of the NHID.
11. Petitioner Bevins has the right to be represented by counsel at his expense.
12. Counsel that represents any party to this proceeding shall file a Notice of Appearance in accordance with Ins 203.04(b) with Clerk Sarah Prescott as soon as possible.
13. Any other motions of any party shall be filed as soon as possible in order to expedite the scheduling of a pre-hearing conference to aid in the disposition of the proceeding in accordance with Ins 204.13.
14. Any party may request a transcript of the proceeding. The party requesting a transcript of the proceedings shall file a written request for a certified court reporter with the Hearing Officer at least 10 days prior to the scheduled hearing date. The costs incurred for the services of a certified court reporter shall be borne by the requesting party.
