**CONSENT ORDER**

This Consent Order is made between the New Hampshire Insurance Department ("NHID") and Diana L. Webb ("Respondent").

1. The Respondent is a resident New Hampshire licensed insurance producer.
2. The NHID alleges that in the course of writing an automobile policy for a customer in 2013, the Respondent violated RSA 402-J:12, I(h) by falsifying a customer's signature on two forms, a New Hampshire residency form and a Reinstatement form.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby agreed and ordered:

- A. The foregoing recitals are hereby adopted, incorporated into and made a part of this Consent Order.
- B. The Respondent agrees to voluntarily surrender her producer's license, effective the date the Insurance Commissioner executes this Consent Order. The Respondent acknowledges that while she may apply for a new New Hampshire insurance producer's license in the future, her application shall be subject to the same review as any other application for a new license.
- C. The Respondent further agrees to pay an administrative fine in the amount of one-thousand dollars (\$1,000). The Respondent may pay the fine in three installments according to the following payment schedule: four-hundred dollars (\$400) within ten (10) days of the Insurance Commissioner's execution of this Consent Order; three-hundred dollars (\$300) by January 30, 2015; and, finally, three-hundred dollars (\$300) by April

30, 2015. The checks must be made payable to "Treasurer, State of New Hampshire," and should be mailed or hand-delivered to the attention of Carolyn Petersen, New Hampshire Insurance Department, 21 South Fruit Street, Suite 14, Concord, New Hampshire 03301.

D. The Respondent acknowledges that by entering into this Consent Order she waives the right to an administrative hearing in which the above-described matters would be adjudicated before a Hearing Officer.

E. The Respondent does not admit to any violation of New Hampshire insurance law and enters this Consent Order to purchase her peace and to resolve the allegations at issue in this case. This Consent Order is not intended to be, nor should it be interpreted as, an admission against interest by the Respondent.


F. This Consent Order shall be deemed a full and final resolution and is in lieu of any other action that could have been brought by the NHID relating to matters disclosed herein.

G. This Consent Order shall be fully enforceable in any Superior Court in the State of New Hampshire and shall be governed by the laws of the State of New Hampshire.


