In Case No. 2012-0253, Appeal of Thomas F. DeSteph, the clerk of court on August 6, 2012, issued the following order:

Certified copy of the record having been filed in the clerk's office, an original and eight copies of Thomas DeSteph's brief must be filed on or before September 5, 2012. An original and eight copies of New Hampshire Insurance Department's brief must be filed on or before October 5, 2012.

Each party is requested, but is not required, to submit an electronic copy of the party's brief on a computer-readable compact disk (CD). The electronic copy should be in Portable Document Format (PDF). The electronic copy should contain the entire brief, but need not contain documents that are not computer-generated by the party. The label of the CD should include the case name and the case number, and should identify the brief being filed (e.g., plaintiff's opening brief, defendant's opposing brief, petitioner's reply brief).

NOTE: Your brief must not exceed 35 pages. See Rule 16(11). The appealing party must attach a copy of any decision(s) being appealed. See Rule 16(3)(i). You may refer to the certified copy of the record in your brief. If you intend to file an appendix to your brief, review Rule 17.
