Consent Order

This Consent Order is made between the New Hampshire Insurance Department ("NHID") and Armand J. Fisher ("the Respondent"), the terms of which are as follows:

1. The Respondent is a non-resident producer licensed to sell life insurance in New Hampshire.
2. The Respondent signed a Stipulation and Consent Order with the State of Connecticut Insurance Department effective September 21, 2015. This was a final administrative action.
3. NH RSA 402-J:17, I requires that "(a) producer shall report to the commissioner any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency in this state within 30 days of the final disposition of the matter. This report shall include a copy of the order, consent to order, or other relevant legal documents."
4. The Respondent failed to report the Connecticut Insurance Department administrative action to the NHID as required by NH RSA 402-J:17, I.
5. Respondent's business address is listed in NHID licensing records as METLIFE, 45 Glastonbury Blvd, FL 1, Glastonbury, CT 06033. This is also the business address Respondent provided to the NHID on his renewal licensing application dated June 23, 2015.

6. Respondent informed the NHID by letter dated March 16, 2015 that he resigned from METLIFE in 2013. According to NHID licensing records, all his appointments with METLIFE companies were terminated November 14, 2014 and December 1, 2014. FINRA records show that since October 4, 2013 Respondent has been employed by Signator Investors, Inc., 100 Corporate Place, Suite 210, Rocky Hill, CT 06067.
7. NH RSA 402-J:7, VI requires that a change in address shall be reported to the commissioner within 30 days of the change.
8. Respondent failed to report a change in business address as required by RSA 402-J:7, VI.

WHEREFORE, for the purpose of resolving the above-referenced matter and in lieu of further administrative proceedings, the NHID and the Respondent have reached an agreement as follows:

- A. The foregoing recitals are hereby adopted, incorporated and made a part of this Consent Order.
- B. The Respondent agrees to pay a fine in the amount of \$750.00 (Seven Hundred and Fifty dollars). Payment in full shall be due upon the Respondent's execution of this Consent Order. The settlement check shall be made payable to: "Treasurer, State of New Hampshire" and mailed to the New Hampshire Insurance Department, 21 South Fruit Street, Suite 14, Concord, NH 03301, Attn: Ms. Carolyn Petersen.
- C. By entering into this Consent Order, the NHID and the Respondent intend to resolve all issues relating to the above-mentioned matters. This Consent Order shall be deemed a complete settlement and full and final resolution, and is in

lieu of any other action that could have been brought by the NHID relating to matters disclosed herein. Provided however, notwithstanding the foregoing, the NHID may take any and all appropriate actions should the Respondent violate any provision of the State's insurance laws in the future.


D. Respondent agrees to comply with all insurance laws of the State of New Hampshire, including, but not limited to, all provisions of RSA 402-J of the New Hampshire Revised Statutes.

E. This Order shall be construed and enforced in accordance with, and governed by, the laws of the State of New Hampshire without regard to principles of conflict of laws.
