RE: Change of Residency

Traditionally, when an insured cancels an auto policy, a short rate cancellation occurs.

It would be inappropriate to penalize an insured for a change of address particularly when their signed residency affidavit compels them to notify you when they cease to be a New Hampshire resident.

Therefore, I ask that you treat such instances on a pro rata basis vs. a short rate.
