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There have been changes to the requirements in RSA 281-A:64.

OLD LAW

- Employers with 10 Employees shall have a Written Safety and Health Program.
- Employers with 10 Employees shall biennially file a Safety Summary Form.
- Employers with 5 or more Employees shall establish a Joint Loss Management Committee.

NEW LAW CHANGES

- Employers with 15 Employees shall have a Written Safety and Health Program.
- Employers with 15 Employees shall file a Safety Summary Form one time.
- Employers with 15 Employees shall update the Written Program biennially.
- Employers with 15 Employees shall establish a Joint Loss Management Committee.

These changes take effect January 1, 2013. Employers who have a current (2011 or later) Safety Summary Form on file with the NH Department of Labor will not be required to file again. Employers who have not filed a Safety Summary Form since 2010 or who have never filed before are subject to the requirements of the revised law.
