### **ADDENDUM #1 TO RFP 2012-03**

#### **Installation, Operation, Maintenance and Management Of Automated Teller Machines (ATMs)**

Page 7, VII K –

*“The security chest shall be designed to comply with latest regulations, (e.g., Regulation P of the Bank Protection Act and UL 291). The units shall be equipped with an alarm system. The successful Proposer shall also provide internal surveillance camera systems for each location.”*

A different vault can be proposed, however, if a different vault is proposed, documentation should be included as to why it was chosen and how it provides the required level of security needed. Internal video cameras will not be required in all locations. Understanding the additional cost required, we have decided to limit this requirement of internal cameras to only 12 of the 25 locations where ATMs will be installed. Some type of alarm is required in all locations to notify the central office if issues arise.

Page 8, VII R –

Remove and replace with:

“The successful proposers must provide, install, operation, and maintain, at its own cost and expense, all equipment, including telephone connections necessary to conduct its business at the retail outlets. The hope is that the ATMs will be installed locations where electrical outlets are already in place. If this is not the case the cost for the electrical outlet will be borne by the NHLC.
