RULES TO BE ADOPTED

Liq 510.01-510.07, Liq 706.40, and Liq 1102.06:

These rules set forth the manner in which an alcohol consultant will operate his or her alcohol consultant business in the State of New Hampshire. The rules also prescribe the manner in which the NH Liquor Commission-Division of Enforcement and Licensing will regulate this new license category.
