6. (a) Summary of what the rule says and the effect of the rule on those regulated:

These rules stipulate requirements for individual license types, as required by the licensing statutes (RSA Chapter 178) and certain other statutes, such as RSA177:9-16 for agency store licensees or RSA179:5-a for sellers of keg beer. The rules contain explanations as to how licensees can meet the requirements of statute to obtain and keep their licensees, and how they report sales or additional license fees to the commission. The majority of the chapter has expired and is being adopted again with minor revisions. Sections 503.04 and 506.07 have language changes to clarify statutory requirements.

Holders of NH liquor licenses and persons wishing to open businesses selling liquor.
