The Laborer position entails unloading trucks and stores liquor received from the Warehouse. Marks prices on liquor products and stocks shelves in the store. Performs housekeeping and maintenance jobs such as sweeping or mopping floors, dusting shelves or cleaning washrooms. Guides customers in identifying and locating desired items. Brings in shopping carts and cleans the area around the store and other duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Education: Completion of eighth grade or its equivalent.

Experience: One year of related work experience.

Special Requirements:

- Frequent physical effort required in continuous lifting of material up to 25 pounds with frequent lifting of cases of liquor weighing up to 60 pounds
- Applicants must be able to satisfactorily undergo a criminal records check.
- Knowledge of Wine products is helpful
- Applicant must have attained 18th birthday on or before date of application.

The following items are a requirement and need to be completed as a condition of employment:

- **Criminal records check**
- **Reference check**

These checks will be performed at the Liquor Commission's expense, and will be performed for new hires, transfers and promotions if one has not been completed in the last 12 months.

All employees will have these background checks completed.
