MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Education: Completion of high school, G.E.D. or its equivalent, plus two years of technical training or education in engineering or building trades. Each additional year of approved formal education may be substituted for one year of required work experience.

Experience: Three years' experience in maintenance and repair or construction of buildings or facilities including one year in a supervisory capacity. Each additional year of approved work experience may be substituted for one year of required formal education.

License/Certification: Possession of a valid New Hampshire driver's license and/or access to transportation for statewide travel.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

The following items are a requirement and need to be completed as a condition of employment:

- Criminal records check
- Reference check

These checks will be performed at the Liquor Commission's expense, and will be performed for new hires, transfers and promotions if one has not been completed in the last 12 months. All employees will have these background checks completed. Employees will be required to pay an agency/union fee.
