ORDER LIFTING LICENSE RESTRICTIONS


Now before the New Hampshire Board of Medicine ("Board") is a request from Charles C. Canver, M.D. ("Dr. Canver"), dated July 8, 2014, to remove the restrictions placed on his medical license by the Board in a Settlement Agreement dated March 10, 2006. In his request, Dr. Canver indicates that he no longer practices transplant surgery and does not intend to do so. He indicates he has ceased clinical practice to become a full-time health care administrator. He goes on to say that even though he is no longer a transplant surgeon, the restriction on his New Hampshire medical license disqualifies him from many medical administrator positions. The Board finds that Dr. Canver has complied with all provisions of the March 10, 2006 Settlement Agreement. In light of the above, the Board finds that it is appropriate to lift the restrictions of his license at this time.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the restrictions on Dr. Canver's medical license be lifted. Effective the date of this order, Dr. Canver holds a full, unrestricted license in the State of New Hampshire.
