

FALL 2012 ARTS EDUCATION CONFERENCE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

New!! This year **12 partial Conference Registration Scholarships** will be awarded to teachers in public schools seeking to bring increased and varied arts opportunities to students. Scholarships are competitive and priority will be given to teachers who have not attended the Arts Education Conference in the past 3 years. Scholarships will pay for 50% of the conference registration fee (which includes lunch). Recipients must be able to cover the cost of travel and lodging (if necessary) and commit to attending the full conference (October 19 and 20, 2012). ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS: Teachers (full and part-time) who work in NH public schools

GOALS: To provide a quality professional development experience for teachers; to provide an artistic and educational opportunity to expand and enrich the NH arts education community; to allow teachers who have not previously attended the conference -- or have not attended for the past 3 years -- to benefit from the inspiration and opportunities offered by the conference.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Applicant's background and interest in professional development in arts education and arts integration.

BENEFIT: The recipient will receive an award that covers 50% of conference registration. Scholarship recipients must be able to cover the cost of any travel and lodging and commit to attending the full conference (October 19 and 20, 2012)

PROCESS – *This is a two-part process*:

- 1. In order to apply for this scholarship, applicants must register for the full conference online at www.aannh.org or by emailing, mailing or faxing their registration form to Frumie Selchen, Arts Alliance of Northern New Hampshire, conference registrar (see program registration form for details).
- 2. This Scholarship Application should be emailed or mailed along with the requested materials, *including principal's signature*, to Frumie@aannh.org or Frumie Selchen, AANNH, HC64 Box 223, Wonalancet NH 03897. We will accept scholarship applications until we have given out 12 scholarships.

Applicants will be contacted by Catherine O'Brian, NH State Council on the Arts. Successful applicants will receive a partial (50%) scholarship for full-conference registration. Scholarship recipients are responsible for their travel, lodging and any materials fees.

If you will not be able to attend the conference if you do not receive a scholarship, we ask that you let us know in advance by checking the appropriate box on this application.
