Is it the intent of the Department to have medications at Shea Farm administered by nurses?

Answer #2:

The Department recognizes the complication of having C-2 and C-1 classifications together in a housing unit (Shea Farm) geographically not proximate to either of the larger facilities and will accept recommendations from the Vendors for alternative methods of medication administration that recognizes the importance of tracking medication compliance and proper medication storage. The Department will work with the Vendor upon awarding of the contract to improve Shea farm medication management.
