- Activity Tracking
(NOTE: this would be used if you wanted to “circ” an activity like use of a room or internet access – it isn’t an ideal way to track things, but many NH libraries do this so I added it as an item type.)
- Art work
- Books
(NOTE: this includes all physical books, regardless of content, including graphic novels)
- Downloadables – audio
- Downloadables – ebook
- Ebooks, locally owned
(NOTE: this is separate from Downloadables because these are presumably circulated by your library while the downloadables are made available to patrons via Overdrive)
- Equipment – daily circulation
- Equipment
- Games and puzzles
- ILLs
- In-library equipment (USE HOURLY CIRC)
- Kits
(NOTE: this can include things like books that have an audio version packaged with them as well as testing kits, toy/book combos, book discussion bags, etc.)
- Magazines and Newspapers
- Maps
- Microforms
- Videos
(NOTE: This includes movies, instructional videos, TV shows, downloadable video, etc. in any format)
- Museum passes
- Music - Printed
- Sound Recordings
(NOTE: This includes music, spoken word recordings, audio books, etc. in any physical format)
- Online Resources
(NOTE: This would be used if you wanted to catalog a website, where town reports are available perhaps, or a database to make it findable in your catalog)
- Puppets and toys
- Realia – daily circulation
- Realia
- Software
- Vertical files
- Video Games
- Other (ANYTHING THAT HAS AN ITEM TYPE ON IMPORT BUT DOESN’T MAP TO SOMETHING DEFAULTS TO THIS)
- Unknown (USE THIS TO FLAG ITEMS FROM WHICH AN APPROPRIATE ITEM TYPE IS NOT CURRENTLY DEFINED)
