MODIFICATION OF CERTIFIED BARGAINING UNIT

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2014-035 granting the parties' Joint Petition for Modification, the existing bargaining unit description set forth in the certification issued in PELRB Case No. T-0275 (December 7, 1976) is amended; and it is hereby ordered that the composition of the modified bargaining unit, represented by Contoocook Valley Education Association, NEA-NH for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances, is as follows:

UNIT: All classroom teachers and other professional staff whose positions require certification by the NH Department of Education, including but not limited to Education Technology Integrators, guidance/school counselors and librarians/media specialists; all professional staff whose positions require licensure or certification by a licensing board and all other regularly employed professional staff who provide services directly to students or who assist in the delivery of services, including but not limited to Nurses, Social Workers, Occupational Therapists, Speech Pathologists, Psychologists, Student Assistance Counselors, Pre-School Consultants/Coordinators, Transition Coordinators, Mentors and Portfolio Teachers; all paraprofessional staff including but not limited to LPNs, COTAs, and speech assistants.

EXCLUDED: All supervisory, administrative, and confidential employees, including Superintendents, Assistant Superintendents, Business Administrator, Principals, Assistant Principals, Teaching Principals, Curriculum Coordinators, Directors, and special education coordinators; special program staff, including Literacy Coach, Art Enrichment, School To Work, and Technology Integration Specialist; and other support personnel including facilities staff, administrative assistants, food service workers, transportation staff and technology support personnel.

Further, it is ordered that the above named public employer shall negotiate with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
