Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A) and the results of an RSA 273-A:10 secret ballot election (see PELRB Decision No. 2019-031), it is hereby certified that the New England Police Benevolent Association is the exclusive representative of the employees of the above named public employer in the unit described below for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

Unit: Secretarial positions, Clerical positions, and Professional positions, including Victim/Attorney Advocates and the Paralegal positions.

Excluded: County Attorney, Legal Interns, Drug Prosecutor, Domestic Violence Attorney, Attorneys, Victim/Witness Director, and Office Manager.

The Hillsborough County shall negotiate with the New England Police Benevolent Association as exclusive representative on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of the New England Police Benevolent Association to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
