CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE

A representation proceeding having been conducted in the above matter by the Public Employee Labor Relations Board in accordance with RSA 273-A, Section 10 and the Rules and Regulations of the Board, and it appearing that a negotiating representative has been selected;

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act, and after the conduct of a representation election,

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the STATE EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION OF NEW HAMPSHIRE, S.E.I.U., LOCAL 1984 has been selected by a majority of the employees of the above named Public Employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for the purpose of collective negotiations and the settlement of grievances.

UNIT: Account Clerks, Supervisor Payroll Accounts, Assistant Fiscal Officer, Head Custodian, Custodians, Secretary, Chief Mechanic, Clerk Typist, Deputy Tax Collector, Deputy City Clerk, Assistant Building Officer, Office Clerk, Assessing Technician, Welfare Technician, Groundsmen, Water Front Director, Youth Councilor, Office Manager/Secretary, Senior Engineer Technician, Superintendent of Streets, Superintendent of Sewers, Pumping Station Attendant, Engineering Technician, General Foreman, Foreman, Scale Operator and Parking Meter Collector. EXCLUDED: Executive Secretary to City Manager and Administrative Secretary as Confidential. Assistant Director of Community Development and Night Attendant.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named Public Employer shall negotiate collectively with


STATE EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION OF NEW HAMPSHIRE, S.E.I.U., LOCAL 1984
