Modification of Certified Bargaining Unit

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2022-099 granting the Union's petition for modification, the existing certification, set forth in PELRB Decision No. 2017-056 (April 5, 2017), is amended; and it is hereby ordered that the composition of the modified bargaining unit, represented by the Lebanon Permanent Firefighters' Association for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances, is as follows:

Unit: Captains, Lieutenants, Firefighter/Mechanic, Firefighters, Fire Inspector, Fire Alarm and Communications Technician, and Mobile Integrated Healthcare Employee.

The City of Lebanon shall negotiate with the Lebanon Permanent Firefighters' Association as exclusive representative on the terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit and shall recognize the right of the Lebanon Permanent Firefighters' Association to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
