Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate


Pursuant to the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A) and the results of a representation election (see PELRB Decision No. 2019-203), it is hereby certified that the Londonderry Police Employees Association has been designated and selected as the exclusive representative for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances of the following Londonderry Police Department District bargaining unit:

Unit: All regular permanent Londonderry Police Department employees, including Patrolmen, Sergeants, Dispatchers, Juvenile Officers, Dispatcher/ Records Clerk, Dispatch Supervisor, Detectives, Records Supervisor, Prosecutor, Sergeant/ Technician, Safety Officers, Animal Control Officer, Assistant Animal Control Officers, and part time Records Clerk.

The Londonderry Police Department shall negotiate with exclusive representative Londonderry Police Employees Association on the terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of the Londonderry Police Employees Association to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
