## CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A), and a secret ballot election having been conducted in accordance with RSA 273-A:10, as reflected in PELRB Decision No. 2011-264, 2011-283 and 2011-322, it is hereby certified that the Seacoast Educational Support Personnel Association, NEA-New Hampshire has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named public employer, Hampton School District/SAU 90, in the unit described below, as their representative for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

Unit: Educational support personnel in Hampton School District/SAU 90; specifically paraprofessionals – Teacher Aides, Nurse Aides, L.D. Tutors, Library Clerks and Title I employees, except at Sacred Heart and Odyssey House.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named public employer shall negotiate collectively with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
