### FINDINGS

Rehearing on the unit determination for the Operating Staff of the University System, Durham Campus, was held on February 25, 1977, in Room 306, Legislative Office Building, Concord, New Hampshire.

PELRB in its original decision signed on October 26, 1976, excluded from the unit, Confidential Secretaries to the Dean, Vice Provost and principal Administrators; Library Technical Assistants; Assistant Foreman-Supervisors; Fire Department employees; Police Department employees; System employees (Off-campus, Lee Circle); Cooperative Extension Aides; all Faculty; and, other Technicians, as listed.

Efforts on the part of the parties involved to resolve issues under appeal resulted in an agreement on the inclusion of LTA I and II in the Operating Staff unit, however, the University System sought to exclude LTA III and place them in the PAT category.

In view of all the evidence submitted and testimony heard on February 25, 1977, PELRB reversed its decision of October 26, 1976 in regard to the Library Technical Assistants and also found that the LTA III shared a definite community of interest with the other LTAs and ruled, as follows:

### BOARD DECISION

All Library Technical Assistants (I, II, & III) shall be part of the proposed bargaining unit for the Operating Staff of the Durham Campus of the University System.
