FINDINGS

The Public Employer, through its Counsel, H. Philip Howorth, Esq., on October 9, 1977 requested a contraction in the case of the distribution makes determined by PELRB decision dated September 26, 1977. Reasons for the rehearing request strongly emphasized the City of Nashua's contention that principals did possess a confidential relationship with the City.

The Public Employee, through its Counsel, Gregory D. Prymak, Esq., filed objection to the City's request on October 13, 1977.

Board granted a rehearing which was held on October 19, 1977 at the James Hayes Safety Building, Hazen Drive, Concord, New Hampshire.

The Public Employer in support of their position presented further rationale for the Board of Education Position regarding management personnel in the Nashua School District.

After reviewing all testimony and written evidence presented at the original hearings, June 23 and July 11, 1977 and the rehearing held October 19, 1977, the Public Employee Labor Relations Board **Example 2007** to its original order dated September 26, 1977:
