FINDINGS

June 16, 1977, hearing was held in the James Hayes Safety Building, Concord, New Hampshire. Presented to the Board were various and sundry exhibits bearing on the positions of both parties and oral testimony offered.

After a complete review of all the evidence submitted the Public Employee Labor Relations Board makes the following finding and order.

BOARD ORDER

- 1. Board declines to make any finding at this time on the unfair charges.
- 2. Board orders both parties to return to the negotiation table and further to carry on good faith negotiations.
- 3. City of Dover will be represented by the City Manager or the City Counselor in the negotiations. (Alternate allowed for City Counselor)
- 4. Union will be represented by Mr. Robert Keays or Mr. James Bowen or an alternate for either Mr. Keays or Mr. Bowen.

- 5. Each party will have two potential spokesmen at the negotiation meetings.
- 6. Public Employee Labor Relations Board will be advised by both parties no later than July 15, 1977 as to any progress made.
