ORDER DENYING PETITION
FOR REHEARING

On February 12, 1982, PELRB entered a unanimous decision wherein it found the Respondents guilty of unfair labor practices for unilaterally adopting a new policy relative to personal days.

On March 3, 1982, Dr. Hamilton, for the Respondents, petitioned for a rehearing of the Board's decision. Since the granting of a rehearing is a discretionary matter, the Board carefully reviewed the case and determined that no basis exists for the reconsideration of the previous decision.

We therefore

ORDER that the petition for rehearing be, and hereby is denied.
