APPEAL

The Portsmouth Board of Education appealed PELRB Decision No. 84-64, which found the School Board and its negotiator guilty of unfair labor practices prohibited by RSA 273-A:5, I by failing to conduct good faith negotiations at reasonable times and places in an effort to reach agreement. In its decision, PELRB ordered the School Board to discuss and arrange meeting times and places with the Association even if it necessitated meeting at times during the normal working hours.

Being fully convinced that all evidence had been presented at the original hearing, the Board exercises its right under its Rules and Regulations, Pub. 205.02 and RSA 541:5 and HEREBY DENIES the appeal for reconsideration.
