## DECISION NO. 87-02

## ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR REHEARING

On October 21, 1986, PELRB entered into a unanimous decision ordering the Portsmouth School Department and the Association of Portsmouth Teachers, NEA-NH to proceed to arbitration under the contract provisions and to comply with the contractual requirements concerning the results of that arbitration.

Counsel for the School Department on November 19, 1986 filed a request for reconsideration of the matter on the basis that the Board's order was unreasonable and unlawful.

As the granting of a rehearing is a discretionary matter, the Board at its meeting December 18, 1986 reviewed the submissions from both Counsels and determined that all issues had been discusses and ruled on at the original hearing.

PELRB therefore

ORDERS that the motion for rehearing be, and hereby is DENIED.
