BOARD DECISION

MOTION FOR REHEARING

The Berlin Education Association through its Counsel, NEA-NH Staff, Attorney, James F. Allmendinger, filed a Motion for Reconsideration of the above case, PELRB Decision No. 87-21 stating that PELRB, as in the case of the Hanover Education Association (#87-20) had failed to adhere to its earlier decision and follow the guidelines of the law and its Rules and Regulations; that other professionals whose duties differ from teachers are still included in the professional bargaining unit; matter of individual contracts was irrelevant; and, the community of interest aspect was too narrowly defined.

PELRB found in Decision 87-21, as in the Hanover case, that the nurse's duties were purely health related and not educational and she did not share a sufficient community of interest with the existing teacher bargaining unit members and thereby denied the request for modification.

After a review of the request for reconsideration, the District's objection and the evidence presented at the hearing, PELRB in accordance with Pub 205.05 and RSA 541:5 exercises its rights and HEREBY DENIES the request for Rehearing.
