
#### ORDER DISMISSING PETITION

A petition for modification of the Professional Management unit to include the position of professional librarians was filed by the President of the Professional Management Association; librarians are currently included in the certified unit represented by Local 1386, AFSCME. The City of Portsmouth and AFSCME, Council 93 opposed the change.

Hearing on this request was held at the Board's office in Concord, N.H., September 17, 1987 with AFSCME and the City represented. Telephone contact was made with the petitioner who indicated that a change in officers of the Professional Management Association had occurred and that the current officers had no knowledge of the request.

In light of the above, request for modification was dismissed with prejudice.
