MOTION FOR REHEARING

PELRB on September 11, 1987 approved an all inclusive unit of education assistants, secretaries, receptionists and registrars in the Hanover School District. Election was held on September 30, 1987 resulting in the certification of the Hanover Support Staff, NEA-NH as the exclusive representative.

Counsel for the District on October 15, 1987 filed a Motion for Reconsideration on the basis of the <u>Appeal of Manchester Board of School Committee</u>, 129 N.H. 151 (1987) and the degree of supervision exercised by teachers over the education assistants (aides).

After reviewing the evidence and testimony presented at the original hearing and on the basis that no new evidence was submitted for consideration, PELRB in accordance with Pub 205.05 and RSA 541:5 exercises its right and DENIES the Motion for Rehearing.
