MOTION FOR REHEARING

On October 27th, 1990 the City of Portsmouth by its Chief Negotiator, Thomas E. Cayten filed a motion for a rehearing in the above case alleging that PELRB had made an erroneous decision as a matter of fact and law in its interpretation of certain contractual language.

Representative of AFSCME, Vincent E. Weners, Jr., Esq., objected to the granting of a rehearing.

After reviewing the evidence presented at the original hearing and finding no new evidence to support a rehearing at its meeting November 9, 1990 the Board finds that all issues were raised and discussed and cannot find merit for reconsideration and DENIES the request for a rehearing.
