MOTION FOR REHEARING

Fall Mountain Teachers Association/NEA-New Hampshire by its representative Mary E. Gaul, Monadnock Region Director filed a Motion for Rehearing in the above case, generally alleging that the PELRB erred in making its finding of no unfair labor practice. The suggestion that the PELRB allow cases to go forward to arbitration so that an arbitrator can determine the arbitrability of certain issues, the Boards' interpretation of witness testimony, the finding considering job performance and further the Boards' failure to consider a Motion for Continuance.

The School District opposed the Request for Rehearing on the basis that the finding properly addressed the facts and testimony at the original rehearing.

After reviewing the Motion for Rehearing and all the evidence presented at the original hearing, where all issues were raised and fully discussed and finding no new evidence offered to merit reconsideration, the request for Rehearing is DENIED.
