## MOTION FOR REHEARING

On June 18, 1991, PELRB unanimously created a bargaining unit of all full-time and part-time employees of the Town of Lincoln Police Department and Communications Center and ordered an election held as expeditiously as possible. (See Decision No. 91-39)

Counsel for the Town filed a Motion for Reconsideration on the basis that the findings of the Board did not properly address the Town's position and failed to respond to the Town's requests for Findings of Fact and Rulings of Law.

The findings in Decision No. 91-39 were substituted for the Town's requests after careful review of the petition filed, the Town's argument and all materials submitted at the Unit Determination hearing held in December of 1990.

After considering Counsel's objections to the findings and order, PELRB exercises its rights and DENIES the Motion for Rehearing.
