MOTION FOR REHEARING AND RECONSIDERATION

On August 1, 1991, PELRB issued Decision NO. 91-49 wherein the Board stated that the action to withhold volunteer duties and "work to conscience" constituted an illegal action and that the Federation was ordered to cease and desist such job action. That the Public Employer and its Agents must deal directly with the certified representative and not with individual teachers and charges of harassment, coercion and threats were not persuasive and were dismissed.

Decision was based on all evidence presented at hearing, while some testimony offered could be subject to various intepretation by different individuals. PELRB considered all evidence submitted as its intepretation of testimony offered is contained in its decision No. 91-49.

The supporting evidence offered in the request for reconsideration was fully considered at hearing and no new evidence submitted. The PELRB DENIES the request for reconsideration and rehearing of Decision No. 91-49.
