MOTION TO DISMISS

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on July 8, 1993, took the following actions:

- It examined the complaint of unfair labor practice (ULP) filed by the Association on June 18, 1993 as well as the District's answer filed July 2, 1993.
- 2. It noted the date of the complaint of conduct, namely, the dismissal of Robert Gallagher on December 2, 1991 as well as intervening legal proceedings which included a Petition for Declaratory Judgment filed in Carroll County on April 15, 1992 and the granting of the District's Motion to Dismiss which was granted on Dec. 23, 1992.
- 3. It determined that this case, in the form of a ULP, was not timely filed with the PELRB under RSA 273-A:5 VIII.
- 4. Thus, it DISMISSED the ULP complaint.
