SHOW CAUSE ORDER

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire on July 13, 1993, took the following actions:

1. It reviewed the original unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed by the Union on February 5, 1993 and the Town's answer filed on February 22, 1993.
2. It reviewed and discussed proceedings in this matter held before the PELRB on April 13, 1993, noting the parties' settlement of the sick leave issue as well as the board's directive that the parties meet at least twice in the following thirty days in an attempt to settle any other issues remaining unresolved.
3. It searched its files and found no advisory forthcoming from either party after May 13, 1993 relative to the success or lack thereof of the parties' having met as directed.
4. It directed the parties, or either of them, to show cause within fifteen (15) days of the date hereof why the pending ULP should not be dismissed from the board's docket of active cases.
