MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on September 9, 1993, took the following actions:

1. It convened for the purpose of hearing the unfair labor practice charges filed by the Londonderry Education Association on July 6, 1993 against the Londonderry School District which filed an answer thereto on July 19, 1993.
2. It heard opening arguments by the parties as well as an assertion by the District that the individual allegedly impacted was allegedly not a member of the bargaining unit.
3. Upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously voted, it GRANTED a continuance for sixty (60) days during which time either party will notify the PELRB if further hearing is necessary. If no such notice is received within sixty days this case will then be dismissed.
