## MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on November 9, 1993, took the following actions:

- 1. It reviewed the Joint Motion for Continuance filed by the parties on November 8, 1993.
- 2. It noted that the newly elected school board is first scheduled to meet on November 9, 1993 and is not expected to be able to review and address outstanding labor relations issues completely prior to the scheduled hearing on November 16, 1993.
- 3. It also noted that the parties have scheduled an arbitration hearing for January 24, 1994 which may be dispositive of all or part of the pending unfair labor practice charges.
- Therefore, it GRANTED the parties' request for a continuance, said continuance to remain in effect until thirty (30) days after the rendering of an award by the arbitrator or withdrawal of this case from arbitration, whichever comes first. If the PELRB receives no request to reactivate this case within thirty (30) days

after the rendering of the arbitration award or if this case is withdrawn by one of the parties from further consideration at arbitration prior to the exhaustion of said 30 days, then this case shall be DISMISSED from the active docket of cases maintained by the PELRB.
