## MOTION TO CONTINUE

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on December 16, 1993, took the following actions:

- 1. It reviewed the unfair labor practice (ULP) charges filed by the Board on November 16, 1993 as well as those filed by the Association on November 29, 1993.
- It reviewed the answers to ULP charges filed by the Association on December 2, 1993 as well as those filed by the Board on December 13, 1993.
- 3. It considered the joint motion of the parties filed on December 15, 1993 for a continuance in setting this case for hearing based on their representation that they had reached resolution of these cases and other outstanding matters in the course of negotiating for a successor collective bargaining agreement, the

contents of which will be submitted to voters at the annual meeting of the Timberlane School District to be held in March of 1994.

4. It GRANTED the joint motion for continuance, said continuance to remain in effect until April 1, 1994. If neither party requests the PELRB to reactivate this case on or before April 1, 1994, it shall thereafter be DISMISSED from the active docket of cases maintained by the PELRB.
