MOTION FOR REHEARING

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on April 18, 1996, took the following actions:

1. It examined its decision dated September 15, 1995 (Decision No. 95-64) issued as the result of the Association's filing a contested Petition for Certification for Court Reporters/Stenographers on December 13, 1994 and the State's objections thereto filed on December 27, 1994.
2. It reviewed legal memoranda filed by both parties on March 15, 1995.
3. It reviewed the State's Motion to Defer Ruling on Motion for Rehearing and Motion for Rehearing, both filed on October 13, 1995, and its order granting said deferral up to 120 days as issued November 8, 1995 in the form of Decision No. 95-106.
4. It accepted the State's letter of January 22, 1996 asking the PELRB to act on its Motion for Reconsideration at the end of the deferral period.

5. It GRANTED the State's Motion for Reconsideration and Rehearing, noting, in particular, that rehearing shall be limited to newly discovered evidence post-dating the parties' submission of briefs on March 15, 1995 which formed the basis for Decision No. 95-64.
