## MOTION FOR REHEARING

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on May 16, 1996, took the following actions:

- 1. It reviewed the Association's Motion for Rehearing filed April 26, 1996 and the City's objections thereto filed May 2, 1996.
- It examined the unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed March 5, 1996 and the City's response thereto, inclusive of an answer and Motion to Dismiss, filed on March 20, 1996.
- 3. It reviewed its decision (Decision No. 96-022) granting the City's Motion to Dismiss as issued on April 11, 1996.
- 4. It GRANTED the Association's Motion for Rehearing on the limited issue of "whether or not a party to a collective bargaining agreement commits an unfair labor practice by unilaterally amending a past practice as to promotions without notice and without negotiations."
