ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT


The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, August 27, 1996, took the following actions:

1. It convened to hear the positions of the parties in the matter of the unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed by the Union on May 29, 1996 and the answer and motion to dismiss filed by the State on June 13, 1996 as well as pleading motions filed by the Union on July 2 and July 16, 1996 and by the State on July 11, 1996.
2. It noted that the State had sought a continuance in the transmittal letter which accompanied its Restatement of Motion to Dismiss filed on July 11, 1996 and that it had not been granted.
3. It opened the hearing in this matter at the appointed time of 9:30 a.m. and waited one (1) hour for either or both of the parties to appear.
4. After the parties failed to appear for more than one (1) hour on August 27, 1996, the PELRB directed

that the pending complaint be DISMISSED without prejudice.
