MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on September 5, 1996, took the following actions:

- 1. It reviewed the Union's Motion for Clarification/ Reconsideration filed on July 10, 1996 as well as the State's Motion for Reconsideration filed July 11, 1996 which raised issues about coalition bargaining and which was addressed in our Decision No. 96-075 dated August 27, 1996.
- It examined the unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed by the Union on March 7, 1996 and the State's answer filed on March 26, 1996.
- 3. It reviewed its decision (Decision No. 96-047) in this matter dated June 21, 1996 in which the terms of the July 1, 1995-June 30, 1997 master agreement were held to apply to the Union's sub-unit and in which the Union's ULP was dismissed.

4. It DENIED the Union's Motion for Clarification/
Reconsideration, affirming that the sub-unit is
controlled by the 1995-97 master agreement until
the Union and the State shall have concluded
negotiations on a successor agreement to become
effective on or after July 1, 1997.
